

LONDON'S BIG UNDER-

FOR COMING WEEK

Washington, D. C., April 4-During the coming week there will be numerous elections and primaries, the re-sults of which will afford food for chought on the part of the politicians and the public as well.

The long and bitter contest for the United States senatorship between Congressman Oscar W. Underwood and Congressman Richmond P. Hobson will be settled in the Democratic primaries to be held in Alabama on Monday. At the same time a United States senator for the short-term, ten representatives in Congress, governor and other state officials, members of the legislature and county officials will be selected.

On the same day as the Chicago election several hund d other cities and towns of Illinois will hold their elections. The liquor issue is being fought out from one end of the state to the other and it is believed that the elections will result in a large ncrease in the "dry" territory. Republicans of Maine will hold their state convention in Augusta Thursday. The plincipal work of the convention will be the framing of a platform. The party will make its congressional and state mominations at the primaries in June.




