NEGOTIATIONS FOR

London, Nov. 21-The negotiations for an armistice between the Bulgarian and Turkish armies are now propeeding. The generals of the opposing forces are discussing terms while the armies stand at ease. They ocpractically the same positions as they did at the time of the great battle along the Tchatalja lines for the defence of Constantinople opened on Saturday night.

Nothing yet has leaked out as the course of the negotiations but it is expected in official circles here that something definite will be mile known later today. From available information as to the prevailing feelin Constantinople it is anticipa ed that the terms forced by the lied Lalkan nations will have to harsher than they are believed to in order to cause the Turkish ple potentiaries to reject them.

From Sofia come the report through the semi-official agency at Vienna that the terms offered to Turkey are not uncompromising either in form or substance that they even leave the loor open to modification. It is thought here, that this is likely to turn out to be correct as in view the pestil-nce prevailing on the main battlefield, the allied notions must be keenly anxious to remove evastating scourge


