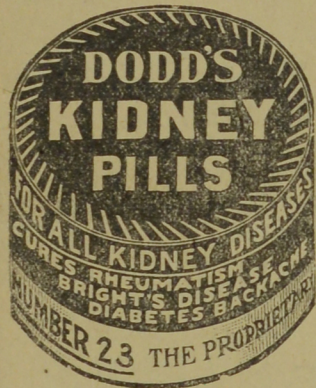

New York, April 12—A London cable says:

Hon. Joseph Martin, the well known Liberal member of parliament, has announced his intention of asking the attorney general in the House of Commons if he intends to prosecute Rudyard Kipling for the offense of sedition for the verses entitled "Ulster."

Mr. Martin will also ask if the government intends to prosecute the publishers of the verses and the printers who set them in type.

Mr. Kipling's poem was published in The London Morning Post. The last lines are:

"What answer from the north?
One law, one Lord, one throne;
England may drive us forth,
We shall not fall alone."

STORY OF PANAMA EARTHQUAKE A MYTH

Panama, April 12—Investigation today disclosed the erroneous nature of the report that thousands of persons had been killed and Indian villages swept away by the eruption of Chiriqui Peak, near Bocas Del Toro, in Panama. There has been no eruption of Chiriqui Peak and Panamanians are at a loss to know how such a report originated.

The report of the eruption and loss of life was brought to Ocala, Fla., yesterday by Captain Olsvik, of the steamer Port Morgan. He said the eruption occurred on April 5 and that he had witnessed flames shooting from the peak. He added that the reports of the large casualty list were brought to Bocas Del Toro by refugees.

The Misses Gilmour Reid teachers of Nos. 1 and 2 District respectively spent Easter vacation at their homes in Fredericton.

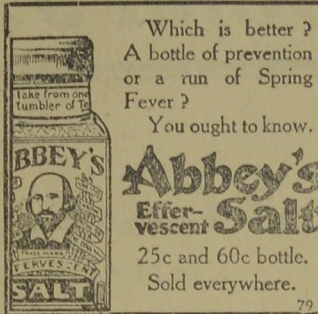

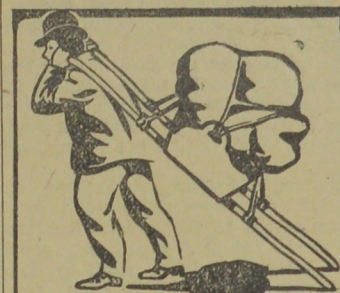

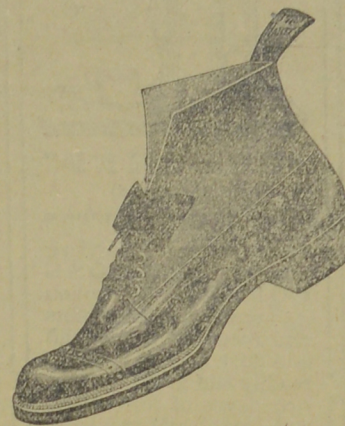
