TWO WIRELESS MEN ON C.N.R. STEAMERS

The Canadian Northern Railway has decided to maintain a second wireless operator on the steamers Royal Edward and Royal George, the company is also transfer to have a searchlight fitted on the Royal Edward for the purpose of making a thorough test of ts allility.
