

New-Brunswick Baptist COLPORTAGE DEPOSITORY.

THE Colporteur Committee of the New-Brunswick Baptist Associations have now on hand a large and well selected assortment of Books for Family and Sabbath School purposes. All the Works of the American Tract Society; also of the American Sunday School Union, may be obtained; also, Historical, Classical and Scientific Works, at the Publishers prices. The first object of the Committee has been to furnish good religious reading in a cheap form, and present it at every man's door—to diffuse as widely as possible the Scriptures, by sale to those who could pay, and by donation to the destitute. They have kept their Colporteur travelling upwards of two years in this service, who has disposed of a great quantity of religious books and tracts. Many Sabbath Schools in New-Brunswick and Nova-Scotia have been furnished with Libraries of from 50 to 300 volumes each, and many Pastors have replenished their Libraries with valuable works from the Depository.

The Committee have also been frequently called upon by Teachers of Schools and Academies for supplies of Books. This has therefore been included as a secondary object, to promote as general and universal a possession of Books as possible for educational uses, by affording their facilities to reduce the cost of School Books.

They are now ready to furnish at their Depository, which is at present at the office of Garrison & Masters, Custom House Building, BIBLES and Testaments of every variety; also, every variety of useful reading.
