Resolved, That the next Session of this body commence on the 3rd Saturday of September, 1857.

Voted, That bro. Robinson, Davis, Miles, Stilwell, and Howe be a Committee to report on the best place to hold the next session of this body.

Voted, That the person having the highest number of votes shall be moderator, and no member shall be moderator two years in succession.

The Committee on Foreign Missions submitted the following Report which was unanimously adopted:

Your Committee beg leave to report that, in the opinion of the Committee, the present state of India should arouse our sympathies in behalf of that benighted land; and that while in this trying time the Missionaries should be made the objects of spiritual prayer. We should renew our efforts to increase our Foreign Missionary Fund.

And while with the deepest gratitude we return our thanksgiving to our Heavenly Father for the mercies already granted to our dear brother Arthur R. R. Crawley. We would most cordially approve of sending him all the funds that can be raised for the support of native preachers in Burmah.

Believing that in this way we shall be doing much more to spread the gospel among the heathen than by sending one from our own land.

In addition to the above, we beg to have the attention of the brethren to the operations of colporteur agents in Sweden, with a view to the raising of two hundred dollars independent of what may be raised for Burmah, to be transmitted through the medium of the A. B. P. S.

Resolved, That the next Session of this Association be held with the Baptist Church in Gagetown, that Bro. Clay preach the Introductory Sermon, and that Bro. Todd be his alternate.

The Committee on Seamen presented their Report, which was adopted, after a warm-hearted address from Brother Walker.

The Committee on Seamen beg leave to report, that they still look with feelings of deep interest on the claims of Seamen to the notice of this Association, and feel thankful for what has been done by the labours of our esteemed Brother Harris, and the Society in Saint John. But there are many other parts in our Province where the brave sons of the deep are wholly neglected. We do, therefore, recommend them to the notice of this body.

But these ought not to depress our spirits or awaken our fears respecting the final issue of a good cause; especially of one like ours, chosen and adapted to cut off, at its source, one of the most prolific streams of human wretchedness.

The achievements of the past challenge our renewed devotion to the cause in which we have the honour of being enlisted, and hold out the assured promise that we labour not in vain.

Moreover, the principles underlying the cause are such as to command themselves to the confidence and support of every well-wisher of the race, such, indeed, as must command the hearty co-operation of all who love the Saviour, and desire to aid in preparing the way for the salvation of souls.

In view of these considerations, your Committee recommends the ministers, brethren, and sisters comprising the churches of this Association, to give their united prayers and efforts in every way proper, both private and public, to advance the cause of Temperance.
