The Princess Louise of Hesse (Princess Alice, of England), was safely delivered of a daughter on the 5th instant, at Windsor Castle. It was reported that the chosen King of Greece, Prince William of Denmark, is destined to be the husband of Princess Louise of England.

NEW YORK, April 26. A Memphis dispatch of the 23d says that six more transports have recently been successful in running the blockade at Vicksburg. They are the Empress, Empire City, Moderator, Anglo Saxon, Chessman and Harrison. Casualties not known. The Freestone and A. D. Hines have taken two double-decked bathos into the Duckport Canal. These boats are capable of carrying 1000 men each. The transports now run by Warrington without difficulty, the batteries being silenced.
