ENGLISH AND FOREIGN.

The daily papers, says the *London Freeman*, contained long accounts on Friday of the splendid and imposing ceremonial by which Dr. Manning, late of Oxford, was consecrated Archbishop of Westminster in the place of Cardinal Wiseman. The crowd was very great, and the ceremony, which was the first of the kind since the death of the late Cardinal, was delivered in good English style by Dr. Amburst, Bishop of Northampton. The *Daily News* says that amongst the many priests who stood round the altar there were not less than a hundred who had either been in orders in the Church of England or had been fellows of English colleges. Dissenters, one would think, instead of joining such universities, are rather noted as a counterpoise, if they could be so, to their anti-Protestant tendencies.

The Prince of Wales, who, like his father, a Fishmonger, was entertained at a splendid banquet by his Company on Saturday. The Chancellor of the Exchequer represented her Majesty's Ministers, but of course avoided politics, though he gave a pleasant picture of what had passed since the last election. Lord Salisbury, in a highly sensible and year, replied for the House of Lords. The chief points in the venerable statesman's speech were an exhortation to the country not to disgrace itself by bribery in the eyes of foreign nations, in which he repeated his wish to make bribery felony—and an earnest exhortation to the people of America, numbering himself with their best friends—that "those who by great military skill, courage, and perseverance, had obtained a victory, would use their triumph as to temper justice with justice, and not stain their cause by shedding blood on the scaffold." He spoke well of President Johnson, as a man who had educated himself, if not to the scholarship of his friend, Mr. Gladstone, yet to be a well-informed man on all ordinary questions.

The week has been marked by two of the most appalling railway accidents on record, at least, in this country. On Wednesday evening, at Birmingham, in which fourteen persons were killed, and about fifty have been seriously injured; the other at Staplehurst, in Kent, in which ten persons were killed on the spot, and many injured. The cause in both cases was the same—the line was undergoing repairs, and the workmen and their superintendent had not properly warned the coming trains. The jury has passed severe censure in regard to several acts of the management of the railway, and has ordered that they be returned to their homes with security, and resume possession of their property. He also announces that no home guards or armed bands, for self-protection, will be permitted in the State, as the military authorities of the United States are sufficient to protect persons and property. All acts of the rebel Governor and Legislature of Texas are declared illegitimate.

Boston, July 10.

The *Times* despatch says Major Shipman has arrived in Washington with the first lot of captured Rebel archives, containing a complete record of the proceedings of the Rebel Provisional Congress, at Montgomery. Also the entire official history of the Rebel Army of the Tennessee, under Bragg, Johnson, and Hood. Also the books of the Rebel Treasury Department.

There is good reason to believe the report that Jeff. Davis will be tried by a military commission on the charge of complicity in the assassination of President Lincoln. Rooms in the Old Penitentiary Building are already being enlarged for such purposes.

The Mexican Gen. Cortinas, in an interview with the Federal Gen. Brown, had informed him that he intended giving up opposition to the Government of Maximilian. Gold 140.

Ford's Theatre, in Washington, was advertised to reopen last night. A large number of tickets were sold, when indications of disturbance being apparent, it was closed by order of the War Department.

The room where the recent conspiracy trial took place, is being enlarged, and it is expected that Jeff. Davis will soon be on trial, charged with being a leader in the conspiracy.

Major Gen. Sickles has returned to Washington from his South American mission. The rumors that he was sent to negotiate for the colonization of emancipated negroes, are set at rest by his official report. When the time comes for the practical enforcement of the Monroe doctrine, the successful results of this important mission will be known.
