How IT FIGURES UP .- The Atlanta, Georgia Templar says: "An employee in this city, at a salary of \$720 per annum, called to see a grocery merchant from whom he had purchased provisions, and was owing him a small bill. The employee expressed regret that he was unable to settle the account, having a family to support. The merchant was disgusted with the report, and asked the employee to make a small calculation, handing him paper and pencil-says the merchant, "how often do you take a drink ?"

Employee-Only two a day, and I get both for 25 cents; this multiplied by 312 "being the number of bold drinking days in the year," amounts to \$36.30.

Merchant-Do you treat your friends? Employee-Outside of my own drinks, I do not spend over five cents per day. This added, makes \$48.40. The employee was astonished and told the merchant he would join the temperance cause and pay him the \$25.00.

England is passing through such a time of destitution as she has not known for a very long time. Seven hundred million dollars a year would be, however, quite enough to restore comfort to all her distressed families. Seven hundred million dollars was what she spent last year on liquor. Had it been saved she would not only have been the richer by that, but by a great deal more not only in the way of savings last year, but in the way of added power for this. Canada has hard times too. Canada expends in the same useless way, according to a recent speech, about thirty millions annually, quite enough to make the worst times she ever had prosperous. So long as these expenditures go on, nations have no business complaining of hard times.

The improvidence of drink was forcibly illustrated by a temperance lecturer, named Campbell, in the following advice to dram-drinking husbands: "Make your wife your barkeeper Lend her \$2 to buy a gallon of whiskey. When you want a drink pay her ten cents for it. An average of sixty-five drinks to a gallon will give her \$6.50. She can then pay you back the \$2, buy another gallon, and still have a balance left of of \$2, 55. Keeping on this way she will have money enough to support you when you have become a confirmed inebriate, and will be able to take care of you until you are ready to fill a drunkard's grave."

### Kousehold.

COLOGNE WATER. - One pint of alcohol, sixty drops of lavender, sixty drops of bergamot, sixty drops essence of lemon, sixty drops of orange water; to be corked up and well shaken. It is better for considerable age.

TOOTH POWDER.—Honey mixed with pure, pulverized charcoal, is said to be excellent to cleanse the teeth, and make them white. Lime water with a little Peruvian bark, is very good, to be occasionly used by those who have an offensive breath.

INK SPOTS .- If soaked in warm milk before the ink has a chance to dry, the spot may usually be removed. If it has dried in, rub table salt upon it and drop lemon juice upon the salt. White soap diluted with vinegar is likewise a good thing to take out ink spots.
