Temperance.

Dr. Talmage on Drink.

In a recent sermon on "The Gates of Hell." at Brooklyn, Dr. Talmage made these remarks about the drink traffic:


"The wine cup is the instigator of all impurity, and the patron of all uncleanness. So far as God may help me I shall be its unending foe. It was the testimony of the officials on the night of our exploration that nearly all those who frequent the houses of death, go there intoxicated. The mental and spiritual abolished, the brute ascendant. Tell me a young man drinks and I know all the rest. Let him become the captive of the wine glass and he is the captive of all other vices. No man ever runs drunkenness alone. That is one of the carrion crows that goes in a flock. If that beak is ahead you may know that the other beaks follow. In other words, strong drink unbalances and dethrones, and makes him a prey to all the appetites that choose to alight on his soul. There is not a place of sin on this continent but finds its chief abettor in the places of inebriety. There is a drinking bar before it, or a bar behind it, or a bar over it or a bar under it. The officer said to me that night: You see how they escape legal punishment, they are licensed to sell liquor. Then I thought within myself, the Court which licenses the sale of intoxicating liquors, licenses gaming houses, licenses libertinism, licenses all crimes, all sufferings, all diseases, all woes. It is the Legislatures and Courts who swing wide open this grinding, roaring, stupendous gate of the lost."

Mr Gough.

John B. Gough had a grand reception on the occasion of his visit to Edinburgh, Scotland. In one of his addresses in that city he said: "I wish to put myself right on prohibition. I am a thorough prohibitionist, for we must not only abstain, but educate public oplnion to vote right at the ballot-box on this question. We often hear it said that the Maine Law is a fail ure; that is false, for it is a grand success. True, in Massachusetts it has been reversed but why? Simply because temperance people sat at ease after the law was passed, and neglected to educate the rising generation, so that when the vote came we were in the minority Let us sink all differences; let bygones be by. gones, and by education of personal abstinence for the individual, and prohibition for the nation, success is certain..."
