New Contingent Being Discussed Joyfully at the Montreal Armories.

The opportunity of another adventure in South Africa which, will be afforded by the extra contingent of 600 men, is going to be taken advantage of by many men who served in one of the previous contingents. At the Montreal armories Wednesday night many men who have worn khaki before, declared their intention of offering their services in the proposed contingent.

One of them who apparently voiced the opinions of many, said: "When we got orders at Pretoria to start for home I swore that if I ever got safely back to Canada the diamonds of Kimberley would not induce me to come to Africa again. But campaigning gets in a man's blood I think. Ever since I got home I have been home sick for Africa, and I am going to try and fill one of those 600 saddles that are going out to chase DeWet. I owe him a grudge anyway. I chased him before until I wore out four pair of shoes and was almost starved to death and did not catch him. I always thought that if I only had a horse under me I would stand a better chance of getting a crack at the slippery Dutchman. I am going back to have another try."

There have been several applications from Montreal officers for commissions in the force, and the order to begin recruiting is awaited by local soldiers with the greatest impatience.

In the same room, side by side, the bodies of husband and wife lay last night, watched over by their children. Both born in Germany, the husband in Stuttgart and the wife in the Black Forest, each some seventy-five years ago, they had been married soon after they came to this country, forty-five years ago. No more loving couple the neighbors say, ever lived in Williamsburg.

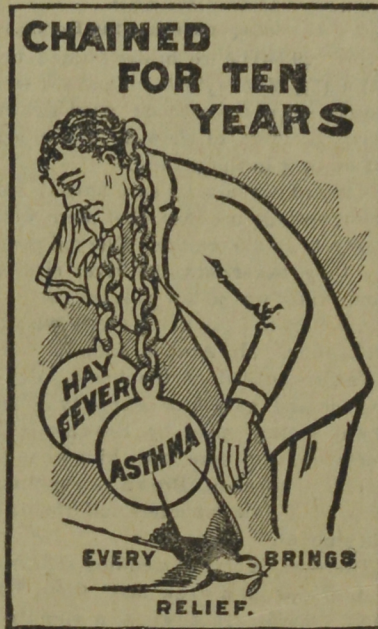
