Interesting Occurrences

FROM LATE DESPATCHES AND EXCHANGES.

The Dominion Statutes are to be revised soon. The last revision was about fifteen years ago.

South Waterloo Liberals nominated Dr. Thompson, of Galt, for the legislative Assembly.

Kingston Liberals will nominate a successor to Mr. Justice Britton in the commons on Thursday next.

The Countess of Aberdeen, wife of the former Governor-General of Canada, speaking at a gathering in Dundee, Scotland, said that Great Britain had squandered her sons and her money in Africa, while she allowed the Americans to buy up commercial interests here and in Canada.

The Dominion Coal Co. of Cape Breton expects to raise six million tons annually and are very sanguine of securing a foothold in the European markets. Parties are now en route from Germany, for the purpose of negotiating the purchase of a large quantity of coal here.

Shortly before noon Saturday the doors of the National Bank of Boyertown, located at Boyertown, Pa., was closed. A notice posted on the bank's doors stated that it was done because of the disappearance of Cashier Milton A. Morey, who has not been seen for a week. An official of the National Bank, of Boyertown, visited the city to-day, and an examination was made after the bank's doors closed, and not a dollar is missing. He says the bank will probably re-open in a day or two.

Hall Caine, the author, who has just consented to become a candidate for the Manx (Isle of Man) parliament advocates some very radical changes in the government of that island. First of all, Mr. Caine wants to nationalize the steamship service connecting the Isle of Man with England, running it without profit. Then he applies himself to the Manx steam and street railroads, and would furnish the same radical system to them. Land must be treated in a somewhat similar manner, the Manx parliament controlling the drainage, cultivation and tree planting. The banks, of course, are included in this nationalization scheme. Mr. Caine justifies these apparently unprofitable national undertakings by pointing out that the primary factor in Manx prosperity is the island's popularity as a holiday resort, and that it must prosper or decline, as it meets the needs of the visitors.

MACKAY OF FORMOSA.

Life Story of Canada's Great Missionary
Reads Like a Chapter From St. Paul's Biography.

Dr. G. L. Mackay, missionary to Formosa, must be given rank among the greatest Canadians. Whether judged by the qualities of greatness which he possessed or by the great work he accomplished in his less than three-score years of life, the names are but few that may be linked with his. His marvelous combination of physical endurance, courage, initiative, determination, and faith made him a man rarely met with in any generation. As a missionary he stands among the first half-dozen since Paul set up the standard and led the way. The record of his work

among civilized and savage in North Formosa, in the spirit and method and the marvelousness of its results, says J. A. M. in The Toronto Star, reads more like a chapter from Paul's biography in the Book of the Acts than anything else that was ever written.

The life story of Dr. Mackay—his early days in Oxford County fifty years ago, his services as an Ontario school teacher, his student life in Toronto and Princeton, his career as a missionary on the Island of Formosa from April, 1872, until his death there, his two furloughs in Canada, the erection of sixty chapels and the organization of as many mission congregations in all the cities and centres of North Formosa, the building up of Oxford College and the Girl's School at Tamsui, the great hospital work carried on, the training of a native ministry to serve the native churches, the rebuilding of the shattered mission work after the China-France war of 1884 and again after the China-Japan war of 1895, his services rendered to science, to civilization, and to the world's evangelization—all that is a life story worth the living and worth the telling.

When men say loftily that the church is played out, or when they say sadly that heroism is dead, or when they say unbelievably that missions are a failure, they have to reckon on with George Leslie Mackay and his sixty churches, his fifty-four native preachers, and his nearly two thousand living church members, and with a growing Christian sentiment where on his arrival there was not one man in all of North Formosa who ever saw a missionary or heard of Jesus Christ. To know that such men live this day, to feel the touch of their heroic lives, to see them unterrified by any fear and undismayed at any loss and triumphant at the last, is to hope anew for one's self and for the race, and to feel how good and brave and hopeful a thing it is to try to be a man.

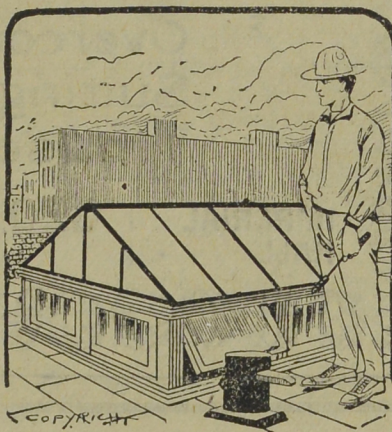
