Queen Victoria's Drawings.

Very few drawings by Queen Victoria have hitherto been made public, but sketching was a favorite amusement with Her Majesty in her days of youth. Fifteen drawings which she made as a present to Sir Edwin Landseer have lately come into the possession of a well-known London editor, and will shortly be published by permission of the King. Some of the sketches were original, others were copies of Landseer's pictures, but they will all be entirely new to the public.

A rather curious story appertains to these pictures. They were etched by the Prince Consort in 1848. The man who looked after the copying press at Windsor Castle stole a copy of the etchings and offered them to a publisher. The Prince Consort protested vigorously against their publication, saying the drawings had been made only for the amusement of himself and the Queen, and were not intended for the public.

But there is no objection at this distance of time. The King has graciously given his consent, as well as to the reproduction of a drawing which he made in his youth to benefit a charity.

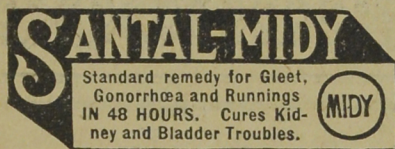

The Dublin Police.

The Dublin Metropolitan Police statistics for 1900 have been published and show that the number of indictable offences during the year was 2,457, as against 2,446 in 1899. Drink appears to have a good finger in the pie, as many of the cases are put down as being due to it. The charges of drunkenness, not combined with any other offence, numbered 6,532, viz., 2,276 males, and 2,556 females. The number arrested for being drunk and disorderly was 2,350, viz., 1,103 males and 1,247 females.

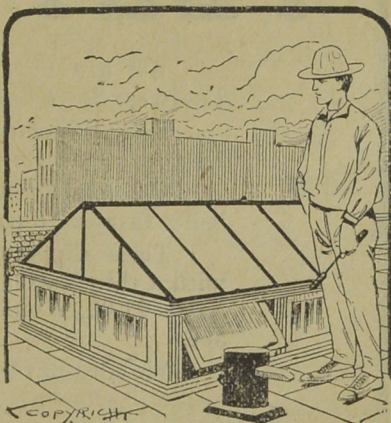
