

A Brutal Attack.

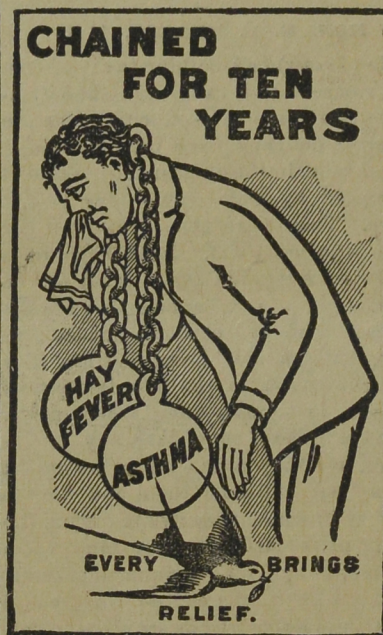
