The Real Difficulty.

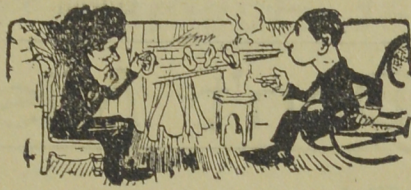
"Yes, I'm studying French. I'm going to take a run over to Paris, you know."

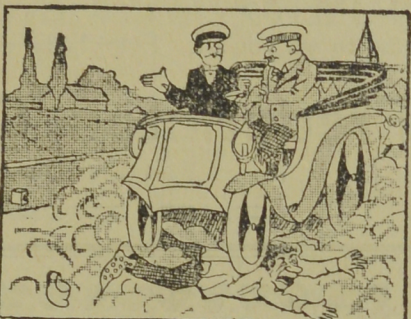

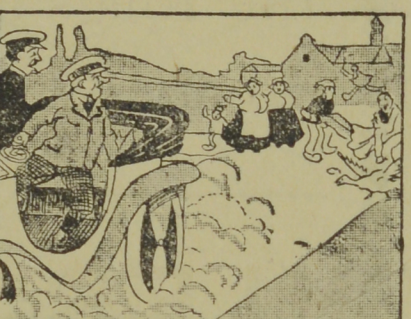

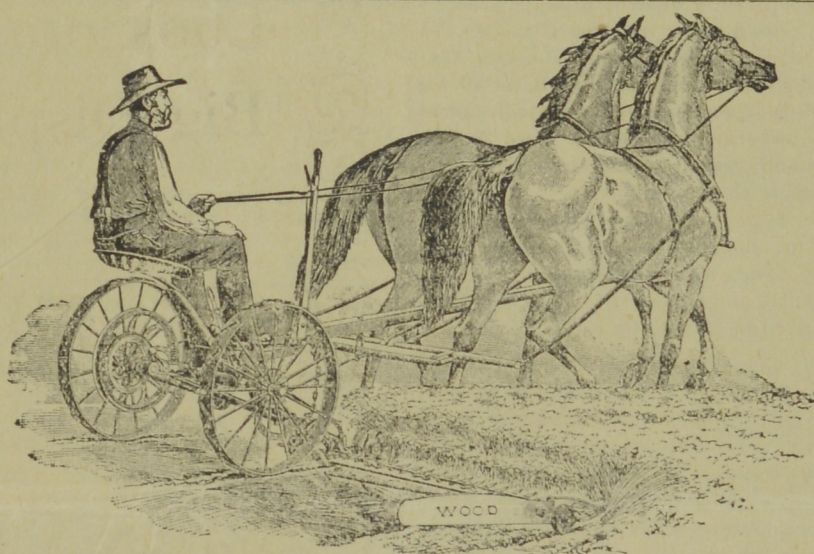
