Melbourne, May 7.—There was a picturesque scene at Parliament House when the procession of the Duke and Duchess of Cornwall and York, accompanied by Lord Hopetoun, the governor general, the state and federal ministers and the guard of honor arrived there yesterday afternoon. Assembled on the steps of the building were the foreign ministers, the representatives of the colonies, including Hon. Wm. Mulock, the Canadian postmaster general, the American and other consuls, the officers of the visiting warships and a host of other prominent persons.

The royal party reached Government House at 4 o'clock. Here there was the scene of the greatest enthusiasm. A salute was fired and the royal standard was hoisted.

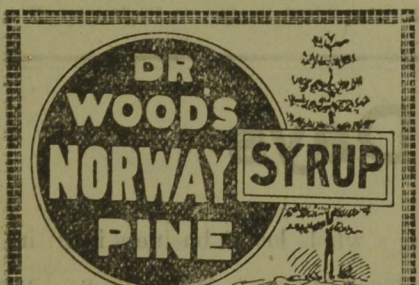
It is believed that a crowd numbering 300,000 persons witnessed the procession. Last night, the city and harbor was ablaze with illuminations of a most elaborate description.

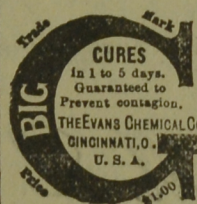

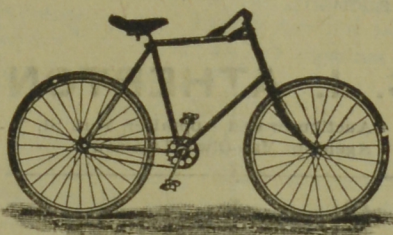

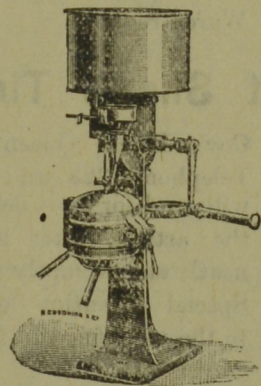
