Ticket Agent's Excursion in a Collision.

Moncton, Oct. 10.—The special train with the Canadian railway ticket agents en route to Sydney passed through Moncton at 8.30 last evening.

The train met with a slight accident at Patterson's siding between Newcastle and Beaver Brook, by colliding with the up-going express which was standing on the main line. The Campbellton express was waiting for the special to take the siding when she was run into. The result was a considerable damage to the regular express engine which was knocked off the track and disabled, but the special train engine was not damaged. The collision caused a delay of an hour and a half to the ticket agents' train and three hours to the Campbellton express. No one was injured.

It is said the collision was due to a misunderstanding about which train should take the siding.
