What Does It Mean?

New York, Nov. 27.—The Evening Post has the following from its London correspondent:—An unprecedentedly large concentration of modern British war vessels is about to be made in West Indian waters. Hitherto the British

Admiralty has refused to follow suggestions for such a concentration, when they have been made by naval officers, for fear of exciting American opinion. This difficulty is now, apparently, considered negligible.

A cruiser squadron under Rear Admiral Sir Wilmot Fawkes, leaves shortly for the West Indies, where it will join in manoeuvres with the British North American squadron under Vice Admiral Sir Archibald Douglas. During the cruise the squadron will be brought up to its full strength, being increased to six new armored cruisers of great power and 23 knot speed. It is believed that the concentration will coincide with an American display of strength in the same waters, though the British concentration was arranged a month ago for British naval purposes. Recent occurrences at Panama and the approaching decision in the Venezuela arbitration, with a possible desirability of a demonstration of British power to quicken Venezuelan acquiescence, will inevitably give it a political appearance.
