

DYNAMITE IN A RAILWAY WRECK

Sets Fire to Oil Tank, and Every House in the Village is Wrecked or Burned.

Dover, Del., Dec. 4.—Greenwood, the little Delaware town of 600 inhabitants, was partly blown up yesterday by an explosion of dynamite in a train wreck and was fired by a subsequent explosion of a naphtha tank. Two persons are dead as a result of the disaster, and nearly a hundred are injured. Many of these are also homeless.

Not one house in the entire town escaped. One residence was destroyed by fire from the burning oil. A score were dismantled, toppled over or ripped open.

To add to the horror and confusion, a driving snowstorm was raging at midnight; wires were down and the houses which remained comfortable were overcrowded.

The dead are George J. Rocab, of Georgetown, a brakeman, instantly killed, and an infant child, which died of shock.

In the driving snow the brakes refused to work on a shifting train and it ran out on the main track just as a south-bound freight train was passing through Greenwood at a twenty mile rate. The crash stopped the train and set fire flying from the derailed engine. Four cars ahead of the caboose was a box car carrying high explosives, in which is supposed to have been a large quantity of dynamite for use in blasting.

There was a deafening concussion that filled the air with flying debris, fire and smoke. The burning oil and overturned stoves soon had nine houses and three of the wrecked cars enveloped in flames, and the terror stricken inhabitants found themselves turned out in the storm.

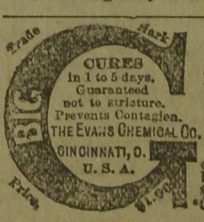
