A Significant Business Letter From
Winnipeg.

SHREWD PURCHASER OF WESTERN REAL
ESTATE

Will Not Close a Deal Till Assured Pros-
perity Will Continue.

Winnipeg, Oct. 27.—The Free Press has received the following letter from Mr. Robert Young, one of Winnipeg's most respectable citizens:—

"To the Editor: Sir,—I have been in correspondence with a gentleman living in Toronto with regard to a purchase of Winnipeg property. On Saturday I received a letter from him, of which the following is a part:—'Should a Conservative government be returned to power, according to their leader, Mr. Borden, they will repudiate the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway bill, and of course this will mean hard times for Canada, for some years to come, and will no doubt affect Canada's credit, and what is perhaps more, interfere with the Sault steel works, and also the steel works in Sydney, Cape Breton. The prosperity of each of these plants depends upon their steel rail output, and if the railway goes ahead they will have abundance of orders for years to come. Then again it will stir up things generally and prevent a reduction in business, and what will prevent this is the building of the Grand Trunk Pacific and the opening up of vast new territories in the west. Having this in mind, you may think I am a little too cautious; but assuming the Laurier government is returned to power, I will be only too glad to take the property and be prepared to make the first payment early in November. Therefore, if on the 3rd of November the Laurier government is returned to power, and assuming, of course, that I can get the property then, you are at liberty to close the transaction and draw on me at five or ten days for the amount of the first payment, and I will honor the draft.'"

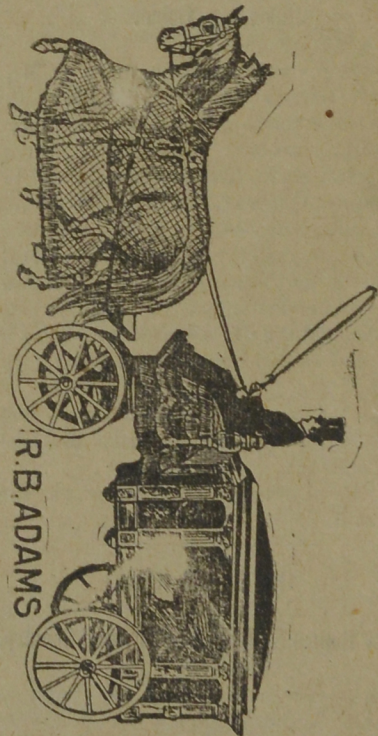
