patrick was educated at Rutgers College, and later at Union College, Schenectady where he was graduated in 1863 in the same class with Garret A. Horbert.

Afterward he received the degree of Master of Arts from Princeton, and in 1866 he began to practice law. Gov. Leon Abbott made him a Judge of the Essex County Court of Common Pleas in December, 1885, and he held that position until 1896, when Grover Cleveland appointed him United District Judge. The Judge was a grandson of Andrew Kirkpatrick, who was Chief Justice of the New Jersey Supreme Court from 1830 to 1844.

Judge Kirkpatrick presided in many noted controversies, and he had a record of having had but few decisions upset. One of his latest acts was to decide that the Globe Security Company, now notorious in connection with the rug-banker Rothschild, must have its affairs untangled in the Jersey courts, rather than in New York, as it was a Jersey corporation. He rendered that decision three days ago.

Whatever criticism was directed toward Judge Kirkpatrick usually came as a result of his connection with the Federal Trust Company of Newark, of which he was President, and the Howard Savings Institution, of which he was a director. There were frequently publications denouncing him for mixing business with

public duty, but such attacks did not worry him at all.

"If anybody thinks I'm not honest because I'm president of a trust company," he used to say, "let him take his case to another court."
