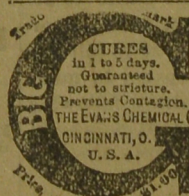

Rubber "Biscuits"

Para Rubber comes from Brazil in huge lumps, known as "Biscuits," weighing usually from 40 to 100 pounds.
