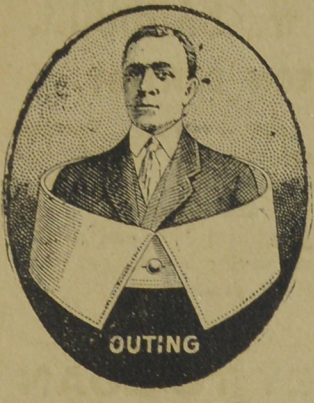

MOTOR BOAT EXPLODED

Two Persons Killed and Five Others Badly Burned

TIVERTON, R. I., Aug. 19.—A gasoline tank in a motor boat in the Seaconnet River exploded last night, causing the death of two persons and serious injury of five others.

The boat was a thirty-footer owned by Joseph Chouinard, of Fall River, and contained four teen young people who had been on a trip to Newport from Fall River and had stopped at Tiverton on their return.

The dead—George Antuya eighteen years old; Lydia Mercier, seventeen years old.

The seriously injured—Joseph Chouinard, aged 20, badly burned about the arms; Joseph Bernier, Rose Durand, Marie Moreau and Albertina Durand, all suffering from severe burns.

Ambulances were summoned from Fall River to convey the injured to the hospital in that city.

The boat had reached a point a little north of the New York, New Haven & Hartford bridge over the Seaconnet when the explosion occurred and the four teen young people on board were hurled into the water. With the exception of Miss Mercier and George Antuya all the party managed to sustain themselves in the water by clinging to the sides of the boat. These two, however, were probably hurled
