HEAVY TAXPAYERS.

Citizens of Fredericton who this Year Will
Contribute \$50 and Upwards to
Civic Treasury.

A COMPARISON WITH LAST YEAR'S FIGURES.

The Board of Assessors handed over the Assessment Roll for 1907 to the City Treasurer on June 27th, and the treasurer has since then prepared all notices and the delivery record book so that the taxpayers will begin to receive the notices on Monday next.

It is the first assessment made under the new law and has been awaited by the citizens with great interest and curiosity. Except in the case of banks and large mercantile houses, the change from last year is not very marked. Many civil service officials and bank managers who have hitherto figured in the fifty dollar honor roll, this year drop out of sight.

The Bank of Montreal heads the list with the very respectable assessment of \$2,138.44, taking the place of the People's Bank, which it absorbed during the year. Last year the Bank of Montreal paid but \$654.03 The Bank of British North America is boosted from \$414.64 to \$1144.30 and the Bank of N.S. from \$262.80 to \$426.84. The other banks are let down fairly easy.

Messrs A. F. Randolph & Sons are jumped from \$297.25 to \$1134.35 James S. Neill from \$413.10 to \$836.63, F. B. Edgecombe from \$1291.16 to \$1726.61, R. Chestnut & Sons from \$327.04 to \$789.50, the N. B. Telephone Company from \$356.24 to \$863.63. John G. Murchie from \$165.48 to \$430.44, J. J. Weddall & Son from \$175.20 to \$428.00, the John Palmer Company from \$198.56 to \$463.30 and J. F. VanBuskirk from \$266.88 to \$569.00.

MONCTON SENSATION.

Money Handed over to Premier Robinson
by Police Magistrate Believed to have
Been Intended as Bribe from
Scott Act Violator.

Moncton, July 13—(Special)—Hon. C. W. Robinson, as acting attorney general, has come into possession of fifty dollars, back of which hangs an interesting tale.

The money was placed in Attorney General Robinson's hands by James Kay, Police Magistrate of Moncton, together with a statement of facts that savors very strongly of an attempt to bribe the magistrate.

Hon. Mr. Robinson, asked as to the truth of the rumors, admitted that the stipendiary magistrate had placed a sum of money in his hands together with a statement how it came his possession but he was not prepared to say much about it.

The magistrate informed him that the money had been found in his (Kay's) house one morning, having been evidently left there by some one who had been there the night previous.

The magistrate informed him that he had advertised the money and the

party called for it claiming he lost it. The magistrate was not satisfied that the party had lost the money, and did not hand it over.

It is stated that the fifty dollars which Kay found in the house was left there after a Scott act violator had been sentenced to thirty days jail.

The party who called for the money in answer to the advertisement had been to see Kay the night before the money was found and what makes the circumstances suspicious is the close relationship between the man who called for the money and the party who was to appear before the magistrate on the charge of violating the Scott act. Some allege that it was an attempt to bribe Magistrate Kay.

The matter will have the prompt attention of Premier Robinson as acting attorney general and further developments will be awaited with interest.

BOWLED OUT OF COURT.

The Case of the King vs. Tonar D's
posed of by Col. Marsh.

In the police court this morning Col. Marsh dismissed the case of the King on the complaint of Mr. W. J. Edgecombe vs. Charles Tonar, a truckman, charged with removing from one of Mr Edgecombe's house a quantity of furniture which had been seized for non-payment of rent. The case was tried before his honor some time ago and created considerable interest.

In his judgement Col. Marsh held that the goods and chattels, which it

was alleged Mr. Tonar had hauled away, had been improperly seized by Mr. Edgecombe, therefore Mr. Tonar had committed no violation of the law. In one instance the levy was made after sundown, and in another case no officer of the law was present. As the goods were not under lawful seizure his honor did not consider that he would be justified in sending the case to a higher court for trial.

Mr. J. H. Barry, K. C., conducted the case for the prosecution and Mr. R. W. McLellan was counsel for the defendant.

Mr. Tonar, who is one of the most popular and honorable truckmen in the city is being heartily congratulated by his friends on the outcome of the case.
