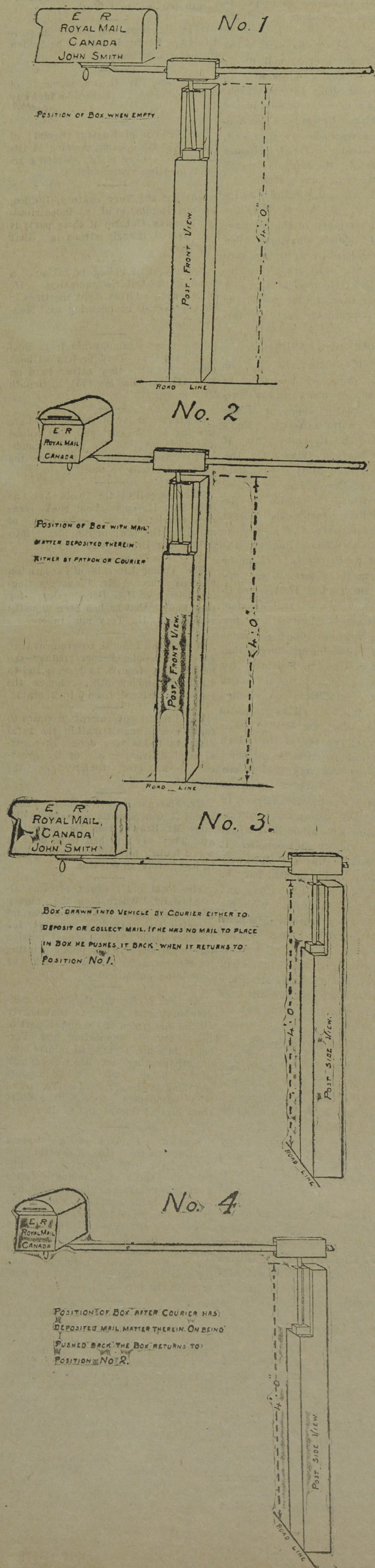


HOW THE NEW FREE RURAL MAIL DELIVERY AND COLLECTION SYSTEM WILL OPERATE.

Greatest Improvement in Post Office System Since Its Organization Will be Inaugurated at Once—An Immense Convenience to all who Live in the Country.



The Herald is able to give here with illustrations showing the operations of the boxes for the rural free delivery, which will be of interest to everyone residing outside the limits of towns and villages.

Hon. Rodolphe Lemieux, Postmaster General of Canada, announced on Tuesday that the government intended to put in immediate operation a system for collecting and delivering mail in the rural districts free of charge to the people.

This is one of the greatest improvements in the department since its organization and is attracting wide-spread interest, and much appreciation from those interested, who form in an agricultural country like Canada the bulk of the population.

All arrangements have been made for its installation and the post office department will proceed at once to inaugurate the system. When this is completed farmers will be able to mail their letters almost at their front doors, and will have their letters, papers and other mail matter left right at the same place. This will save an immense amount of travelling to and from the country post offices. Another feature which will be much appreciated is the saving of the time necessary to answer letters. A letter can be taken from the box and the answer dispatched the same day, when under the present system a delay of several days might occur. The convenience of ordering goods by the farmer's door is another feature of the system.

The mail boxes and stands will be supplied and erected by the department. They will be placed at the junction of every concession line with the main road. The farmers will also have the privilege of having boxes located for their mail if they so desire.

The pictures, which are distinguished by the numbers 1, 2, 3, and 4, show how the system works.

No. 1 shows the position of the box when empty, with the front of the box facing the road. When the farmer places any mail in the box, the box swings around sideways, as in cut 2, so that the collector can see that there is something to be collected as he comes along in the receptacle. Similarly, when any mail for the resident is placed in the box it turns around. After the mailman has passed a glance at the box will show from almost any distance whether there is any mail or not.

The mail box is fixed on a sliding bracket, so the driver of the mail wagon can swing it around and pull it into his wagon, as shown in cut No. 3, and take out or put in any mail without dismounting from his wagon.

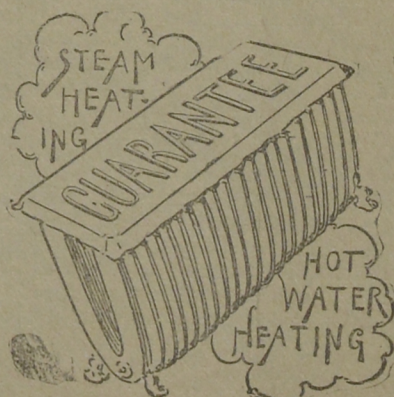
No. 4 shows the box turned sideways by the collector to indicate that he has placed mail in it. When he pushes it into place it will take the position in cut No. 2.

The swinging feature will also enable farmers to mail their letters and take out any mail matter for themselves without any inconvenience if they happen to be driving.

GUN EXPLODED

Thirteen Men Killed in Accident on French Cruiser

TOULON, Sept. 23.—During gunnery drill yesterday one of the big turret guns on the French armored cruiser Latouche Treville, exploded with terrific violence, completely wrecking the after turret and killing outright the entire gun crew of thirteen. A number of men were seriously injured, some of them probably fatally.

The accident was similar to that aboard the gunnery school ship Couronne, off Les Salins d'Hieres, Aug. 12 last, when by the bursting of the breech of one of the guns, six men were killed and eighteen injured. The drill yesterday had been proceeding for a considerable time when without warning, the whole turret seemed to blow out. Dismembered bodies were thrown in all directions and several of them were hurled into the sea through the great breach caused by the explosion. The spectacle was horrible, the dead and wounded, together with shattered arms and legs, littering the decks. A call to quarters was sounded and as speedily as possible the wounded were cared for. The gun that exploded was 7 inches bore, of which the cruiser has two. Happening so soon after the accident on the Couronne, the explosion today has caused a sensation in naval circles, and doubtless will lead to most rigid investigation.

The Latouche Treville carries a complement of 370 men.
