Ex-Premier of England Expresses Views on Decay of Nations.

Decadence was the subject of the Henry Sidgwick memorial lecture delivered by Mr. Balfour at Newnham College, Cambridge (Eng.), recently, and on which the ex-Premier made some significant remarks.

"Why should civilizations wear out and great communities decay, and what evidence was there that in fact they did?" he asked. Though antiquity, pagan and Christian, took a different view it seemed assign to

quity, pagan and Christian, took a different view, it seemed easier to understand progress than decadence. Decadence was always complicated with and often acted through other more obvious causes. It was in vain that historians enumerated the public calamities which preceded and no doubt contributed to final catastrophes.

We felt that some of those diseases We felt that some of those diseases were of a kind which a vigorous body politic should easity be able to survive, that others were secondary symptoms of some obscurer malady, and that in neither case did they supply us with the full explanations of which we were in search.
