JAPS FOR SOUTH AMERICA.

Yellow Men Seeking New Emigration Around.

VICTORIA, B. C., Feb. 4.—News was brought by the Empress of India from Yokohama that since the restrictive measures against migration to America the Japanese emigration companies are looking to South America. The steamer Itsu Kushima has been chartered by the American Emigration Company to take 1,000 Japanese to Peru, and another emigration company has been permitted to despatch 500 to Callao. Representatives sent to Brazil by the Kokoku Emigration Company have returned after making arrangements to send 2,000 Japanese yearly to that country. Arrangements are under way with the Columbian officers now in Tokyo to furnish Japanese laborers for Columbian plantations and railways.

The citizens of Fredericton are likely to be called upon in a few weeks to vote on the question of the repeal of the Scott Act. We, whose names are printed above have been constituted the executive committee of the movement to resist and prevent the repeal of the act. The direction of the anti-repeal campaign having been entrusted to us we will endeavor to prosecute it with the earnestness and vigor which so righteous a cause demands. One feature of the anti-repeal campaign will be a series of articles dealing with the various phases of the situation. That we may reach all classes of citizens, space has been secured in both the local papers. The articles will not all be written by one person, hired for that purpose, and writing over many signatures, but will be contributed by members of the committee and other interested citizens, who do this work because of their concern for the moral welfare of the community. The views expressed and the arguments presented in these articles will be those of the whole committee and the many hundreds whom they represent. In all we say our appeal will be to the reason and the conscience of our fellow citizens. We believe such appeal will not be in vain.

the law of the city of Fredericton. Three attempts to repeal it have been defeated, which is good evidence that at heart the people are in favor of the law. That the present attempt will receive a like answer from the citizens, and with greater emphasis, we earnestly hope.

Notwithstanding many difficulties caused by those whose love of gain make them reckless of the evil consequences of their wrong doing, and in spite of the sometimes lax enforcement of those whose duty it is to administer the law, we are sure it has done much good, and that the city is a much more desirable place of residence because of it. We believe it is capable of doing much more good. And in the event of it being retained as the law of the city, which we confidently expect, we propose, and hereby pledge ourselves to do our utmost to bring about such changes in its administration as will make it in the fullest degree effective in preventing the ruinous drink traffic in our midst. We do not claim that the Act is an ideal law. Like other laws it, doubtless has defects. We do maintain, however, that it is the best law now on the statute books of the country for dealing with the liquor traffic. We hope sometime to have an even better law. Till then and as a help towards securing advanced legislation we believe the best interests of the city will be secured by retaining the Scott Act. We are therefore appealing to our fellow citizens at this crisis to rally to its support.

CANADA CLUB AT DINNER.

LONDON, Feb. 6.—The Canada club gave a dinner at the Ritz hotel last night. The president, Mr. E. W. Taylor, who spoke eloquently, in toasting Canada and the Governor-General, made amusing reference to the encyclopedia "recently revised and brought up-to-date," by a Cambridge professor, which informed the world that the maple tree produced a light and refreshing wine much liked by the native of Canada, and yielded a syrup which when crystallized, supplied the Dominion with sugar.

Mr. Taylor proceeded to criticize the United States in a humorous and, sometimes, sub-acid fashion, emphasizing the financial serenity of Canada, which was undisturbed during the financial storm over the border. If Canada had been to any extent unwise, her follies were those of a lusty youth, and were forgivable, he said.

The remaining speeches glowed with confidence in Canada's future. Admiral Douglas piously hoped that the Admiralty would restore the fleet in Canadian waters. They could man one ship entirely with officers willing to serve there.

Major G. W. Stephens, of Montreal, dwelt on the question of transportation in Canada and the development of her terminals.

Signor Marconi expressed his gratitude to the Dominion government, which was the first to give him practical encouragement. He declared that the wireless system of the St. Lawrence was unequalled in the world. He would spare no effort to show that the encouragement given him by Canada should not be thrown away and remarked that he had just demonstrated to the Admiralty officers what could be done in the way of wireless transatlantic service.
