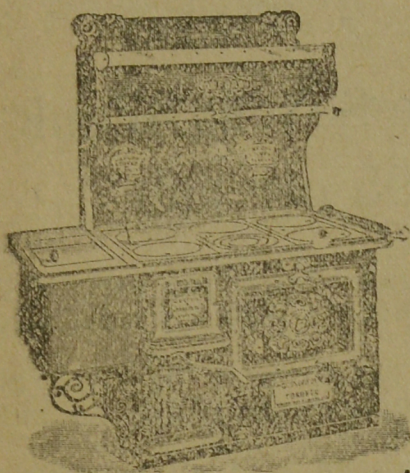

When the First Pony Express Was Nearing Sacramento.

Cornelius Cole, ex-senator from California, tells in his memoirs how the first "pony express" reached Sacramento, Cal., long before the first transcontinental railroad was surveyed: "Those who were there to witness it will never forget the arrival of the first of these express messengers at Sacramento. It was an occasion of great rejoicing, and everybody, big and little, old and young, turned out to see the fun. All business for the time was suspended. Even the courts adjourned for the event. A large number of the citizens of all classes, rode and gay, mounted on fast horses, gave out some miles on the line to meet the incoming wonder.

"The waiting was not long. The little rider upon his blooded charger, under whip and spur, came down upon them like a meteor, but made not the slightest halt to greet his many visitors. Then began a race of all that waiting throng over the stretch back to the city, the like of which has never been seen. It may have been rivaled in speed and confusion by some of the cavalry disasters during the war that presently followed, but the peaceful people of Sacramento, I am sure, never beheld anything of the kind before or afterward.

"The whole cavalcade, shouting and cheering, some waving banners and bareheaded, riding at the top of their speed, dashing down J street, might have been taken had it occurred on the plains, for a band of wild Comanches, but the little mail carrier paid no attention to them and kept in the lead."

A ROMANCE IN TIN.

SOME LEGAL PLEASANTRIES

Mr. Powell Accused of Unfair Tactics at Central Railway Enquiry—Sharp Passages at Arms.

At the Central Railway Enquiry Friday Mr. Powell asked Governor Tweddle if a proper title to the road was secured by the government and witness replied that a proper title had been obtained.

Mr. Powell claimed that such was not the case and Dr. Pugsley replied that there was a proper title and it was on record.

Asked by Mr. Powell if payments had not been made previous to the arrangements for taking the bonds in 1903, the witness replied that the orders-in-council would show whatever payments had been made.

Dr. Pugsley objected to the question and claimed Mr. Powell was misleading the commissioners by making statements that were incorrect.

Dr. Pugsley went on to explain at length how the government had secured a good title to the road and it had been ascertained beyond doubt that all was regular. The payments made had all been regular.

Mr. Powell charged that Mr. Pugsley was making untrue statements. Judge Landry suggested that Mr. Powell should modify his language.

There was quite a spirited tiff at this point between counsel, Mr. Carvell suggesting that Mr. Powell forget that he was trying to make political capital and get down to the facts.

Mr. Powell said he was pleased to have a man of Mr. Carvell's character make such a suggestion.

Resuming the examination Mr. Tweddle was asked if the first mortgage bonds had been deposited with the trustees.

He replied that that matter had been left with the attorney general, Mr. Pugsley.

Mr. Pugsley—"Were they not deposited with the Royal Trust Company?"

Mr. Powell—"Your sweet voice just at this time is not as welcome as it sometimes is. (Laughter.) Your accents are ordinarily pleasing to the tympanum of my ear."

Mr. Pugsley—"What part of your ear, Mr. Powell?" (More Laughter.)

Mr. Pugsley had to retire at this juncture, owing to another engagement.

MR. CARVELL OBJECTS.

Mr. Powell resumed the examination of the witness and Mr. Carvell objected to what he termed Mr. Powell's manner of making statements to get headlines in the newspapers rather than to hold to the questioning of the witness.

Mr. Powell took up a report showing that up to September 1, 1904, the work done on the Minto branch amounted to \$57,643.34 and asked if it was not true that on the strength of this \$11,000 worth of bonds had been issued.

Mr. Tweddle did not think that was correct.

Mr. Carvell said the first portion of that section of the report explained the item.

Mr. Powell—"Let me alone."

Mr. Carvell—"I won't let you alone. You are making statements that are entirely untrue."

Judge Landry—"That is strong language to use, Mr. Carvell."

Mr. Carvell—"No stronger than the facts warrant."

Judge Landry—"I think that the witness can take care of himself."

Mr. Powell (to witness)—"I'm not trying to corner you, Your Honor."

The Governor—"You may corner me if you can."

TORONTO EXHIBITION

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HEMMED IN BY FIRE

Fears for the Safety of Vancouver Island Residents

Winnipeg, Aug. 21.—Despatches from Vancouver Island express anxiety regarding the fate of scattered ranches in burned districts. Numerous settlements are now being threatened and several lumber camps have already been destroyed. In Nooksah district a territory of twenty square miles is ablaze, and flames are fast advancing on Goldstream, where the inhabitants are backing to save their village. The eastern side of Bowen Island is all ablaze, and the fate of eighty old persons in the vicinity is unknown. Some of the richest lumber lands in the province have been swept bare by fire which can only be checked now by a heavy rain.

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
