THE KING'S PRIZE.

**Blue Ribbon of N. R. A. Meet Captured
by English Marksman.**

BISLEY, Eng., July 24.—Corporal Burr, of the London Rifle Brigade, who tied for and lost the King's prize in 1900 in the shoot-off, today won that valuable prize with a fine score of 324. Lieut. Morris, of Bowmanville (Ont.), finished in third place, thereby winning the shield and twenty guineas offered by the Standard of Empire for the marksman from the British colonies finishing in the highest place in the King's prize. Corporal McInnes was fourth with the same score as Morris, losing by only having scored 38 at the 1,000 yard range, as compared with the 43 put on by Morris. The scores of the Canadians who shot in the final stage were:

Sergt. Morris	316	Sergt. T. Bayles, of Toronto, was the only Canadian "in the money" in the Cortis at 600 yards, which is open only to territorials, or members of rifle clubs affiliated to the N. R. A., who are either of the age of 21 years on July 24, 1909.
Corp. McInnes	316	The J. H. Steward cup was given in 1902 by J. H. Steward, optician to the N. R. A., and is accompanied by a silver cup valued at £50, also donated by Mr. Steward. There are forty-five prizes, totalling £75. Capt. McVittie was highest of the Canadians, ninth, winning £2; Blackburn 10th, £2; Huggins, 19th, £1; Kelly, 20th, £1; Frechorn, 30th, £1; Bayles, Frechorn, Hamilton, 31st, £1; Mortimer, 35th, £1.
