FIFTY ONE BODIES HAVE BEEN TAKEN FROM WRECK OF JERSEY ELECTRIC R. R.

ATLANTIC CITY, N. J. Oct. 29--At 11 o'clock today 51 bodies had been recovered from the two cars of the electric car line of the West Jersey & Seashore Railroad, which dashed into the thoroughfare yesterday and one of the cars, the first to leave the rails on the trestle, had been brought to the shore. Of the dead 29 bodies have been identified. How many if any, remain in the second car is not known but with the aid of the 3 divers who were brought here today from Philadelphia on a special train, it is thought that the second car will be completely surveyed before noon.

ATLANTIC CITY, N. J. Oct. 29--As the sickening details of the wreck developed during the night, the disaster became more appalling. The total number of persons whose lives were snuffed out almost instantly is probably 66 with nearly a score of others, several of whom are thought, will die. There were 91 persons on the train, 15 passes and 76 fares. It is possible that some may never be found as it is the belief of the divers that some of the bodies floated through the broken windows out into the thoroughfare and were carried by the swift current out into the Atlantic.

GREAT ACTIVITY NOW ON WEST SIDE OF HARBOR

Following the action of the council on Saturday in completing arrangements for the widening of Union street, Mr. Dowling yesterday put a gang of men at work to build a bridge and lay the tracks as far as the cave-in. About thirty-five or forty bridge-builders are employed in the work, and a railway pile-driver is being used.
