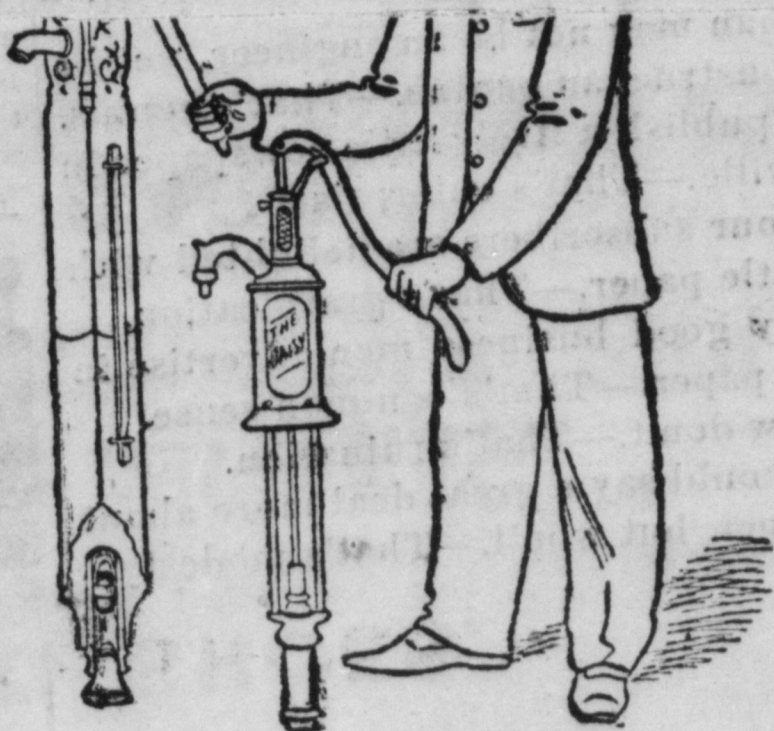

FORESTRY.

Through the courtesy of Bro. Peter B. Millie, Court Deputy of Court Glassville No. 1309, we have received the following interesting facts concerning the Independent Order of Foresters.

During the month of May the number of applications for membership received by the Medical Board was 4,022, of whom 3,611 were accepted, showing an advance of 500 on the highest number of applications ever received in any one month.

The Surplus Fund of the Order on the 1st of June showed the high total of The Temple will be eight stories high and will be the finest Fraternal Headquarters on the continent.

The Forestric year closes on the 30th of June, and in every particular it will be the most prosperous year in the History of the Order.

The increase in the Surplus has been \$360,000.00, and in the Membership about 18,000.
