

A WELCOME WORTHY OF THE CONSERVATIVE LEADER.

Mr. R. L. Borden Given One of the Most Enthusiastic Receptions Ever Accorded a Public Man in This City.

R. L. Borden, K. C., M. P., the able leader of the Liberal Conservative party, arrived in the city Saturday night about a quarter past seven o'clock from Prince Edward Island and was tendered a welcome such as has not been given a politician in this city since the memorable visit of the late Sir John A. Macdonald. From the time he stepped off the train till the vast crowd of enthusiastic followers said good night in front of W. H. Thorne's residence on German street, it was one grand triumph. Rousing cheers greeted the able politician on all sides. They were cheers that came from the heart, not the following by a clique, but spontaneous, enthusiastic and impressive.

AT THE DEPOT.

Even though the train was an hour and a half late, the reception at the depot was a memorable one. Among the leading citizens who were present to meet Mr. Borden were: J. D. Hazen, M. P., W. H. Thorne, W. S. Fisher, George W. McInerney, Daniel Mullin, Ald. Baxter, Ald. Macrae, Col. Markham, R. B. Emerson, Col. J. B. Armstrong, S. D. Scott, T. Barley Boyd, J. King Kelly, L. P. D. Tully and Deputy Mayor McGoldrick. Hundreds of citizens crowded the train shed and repeatedly cheered their visitor.

Mr. Borden drove at once to Mr. Thorne's residence on Mecklenburg street in company with a few personal friends. Deputy Mayor McGoldrick was among the first to meet the opposition leader. Heartily grasping Mr. Borden's hand he said: "I have much pleasure in extending to you the freedom of the city," to which Mr. Borden replied, expressing his thanks and remarking that he hoped he could commend him to the chief of police.

The arrangements for the evening was a smoker in the spacious assembly room of the York Theatre, which were crowded to the doors by eight o'clock, the hour fixed for the opening. The Carleton Cornet band was in attendance and played a number of selections. Pipes and tobacco were provided in abundance and all went merrily as a marriage feast. There were present citizens in all walks of life, all with the intention of giving their honored leader a welcome that he would ever remember, and in this they were most successful. Previous to Mr. Borden's arrival a number of short but interesting speeches were delivered by some prominent members of the party. Ald. Macrae of the middle of a vigorous and eloquent address when suddenly there was a shout of "Here he comes," and for some time the scene was one of the wildest excitement and enthusiasm. The cheering continued for minutes, after which all were given a chance to personally meet the leader, and needless to say all took advantage of the opportunity. Mr. Borden's address was of the proper kind for such a gathering and he

was frequently interrupted with prolonged applause.

The crowning feature of the evening was the

TRIPARTITE TORCHLIGHT PROCESSION, which accompanied Mr. Borden from the theatre to Mr. Thorne's residence. Headed by the band, fully three hundred people fell in line, four abreast. In the parade, all in all it was a worthy welcome to a worthy man, one of whom the Liberal Conservative party from the Atlantic to the Pacific is justly proud.

J. B. M. Baxter, the president of the Junior Liberal Conservative Association, under whose auspices the smoker was held, acted as chairman. In a brief introductory speech he welcomed all to the smoker, stating that as the train had been late, Mr. Borden would consequently be a few minutes late in arriving. In the meantime the meeting would be in charge of itself.

Dr. A. A. Stockton was invited to make a brief address, which he did in his usual entertaining way. They were there, he said, to meet the leader of the great liberal conservative party, whose conduct of the party's affairs had fully justified their expectations. Dr. Stockton then closed with a request that in the next election they cast their votes for the conservative candidates, as that party were working for the best interests of the province of Canada and the port of St. John.

Chas. A. Everett followed with a few brief remarks, referring to a speech which he had made at the meeting of the Liberal Conservative party in St. John the winter port of Canada. While in parliament he had stood up for St. John in all matters and had done his best for his constituents.

A song by Mr. Purling followed, after which Ald. Macrae was called to the front. He said that succeeding as he did Dr. Stockton and Mr. Everett he hardly knew what to say, but as a citizen of St. John he considered it a very healthy sign indeed, but when the people did not know whether there was to be an election or not, the arrival of the leader of the conservative party should call forth such a large audience to see that man and to hear him speak. The citizens of St. John knew of the plank in his platform with regard to national unity, and that policy must appeal to them not only as citizens of St. John but as citizens generally who wish to see this great Canada prosper. Therefore it was but natural that a man who had taken such a policy should receive such a welcome.

MR. BORDEN'S ARRIVAL.

As Ald. Macrae finished speaking Mr. Borden arrived amid cheers, which were enthusiastically given again and again by the large number present. Shortly after he had taken his seat on the platform Mr. Baxter, in a few well chosen words, welcomed Mr. Borden to the meeting and on behalf of the Young Men's Liberal Conservative Association expressed appreciation in having their leader present.

After a couple of songs had been rendered by Harry Dody in his usual entertaining manner, John McAllister called the meeting and briefly addressed the meeting. Mr. McAllister said that he was very glad to meet the honored leader for the first time, and he wished him, as well as the party in

general, every success and prosperity in the future.

R. D. Wilnot, M. P. of Queens county, said that it had been his good fortune to serve under Mr. Borden at Ottawa since 1890 and he felt proud of him, for he had continued to grow in strength and friendship by his fair and reasonable debate. Only a few months ago Mr. Borden had been compelled to be absent from the house for three weeks, and he was very much missed. When he did return his opponents cheered him quite as heartily as his own supporters. Why? Simply because he had been a fair dealer with the public affairs. Mr. Wilnot said that according to reports we were on the eve of an election, but he believed the Lord Himself only knew when it would be held. He referred to the Grand Trunk Pacific scheme and the careless and unpractical methods which the government had used in dealing with it. He believed the liberal party were divided and that the time had come when the people of Canada were desirous of a change.

Mr. Chairman and Gentlemen:—I am sure that no one could fail to be delighted with a reception so warm, cordial and generous as that you have tendered me to-night.
